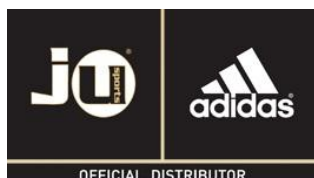

Those who are not recognized as adults by law in their own country must submit a written consent of their parents or lawful guardian accepting the participation and all parts of the official invitation (liability waiver).

Coaches:

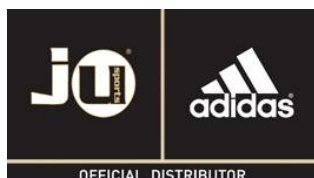
ID Cards for coaches. For 4 athletes 1 coach has free admission. Maximum of 3 coaches for each club. More ID cards can be purchased at the registration.

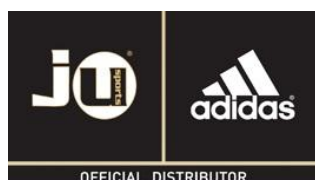

General Information regarding the form specifications:

Every running Poomsae will be drawn by lot.
In each competition different Poomsae will be run.
Achieved points from the rounds before, will not count to the new run.
The forms have to be presented in the same order as they were drawn.

The Poomsae runs will be defined obligatory for all categories by the competition coordinators.

The organizer reserves the right to shorten the lead and the semi final on a form. In the final two forms are presented.

After that (starting not later than 1 minute after the end of the first poomsae) the athlete has to start with the second form.

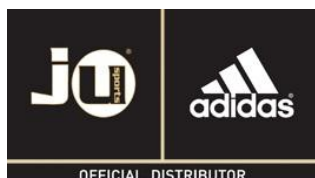
Delays will lead to sanctions subtracting points.

By deuce after the final round a play-off is necessary. You must run a form order by tournament management.

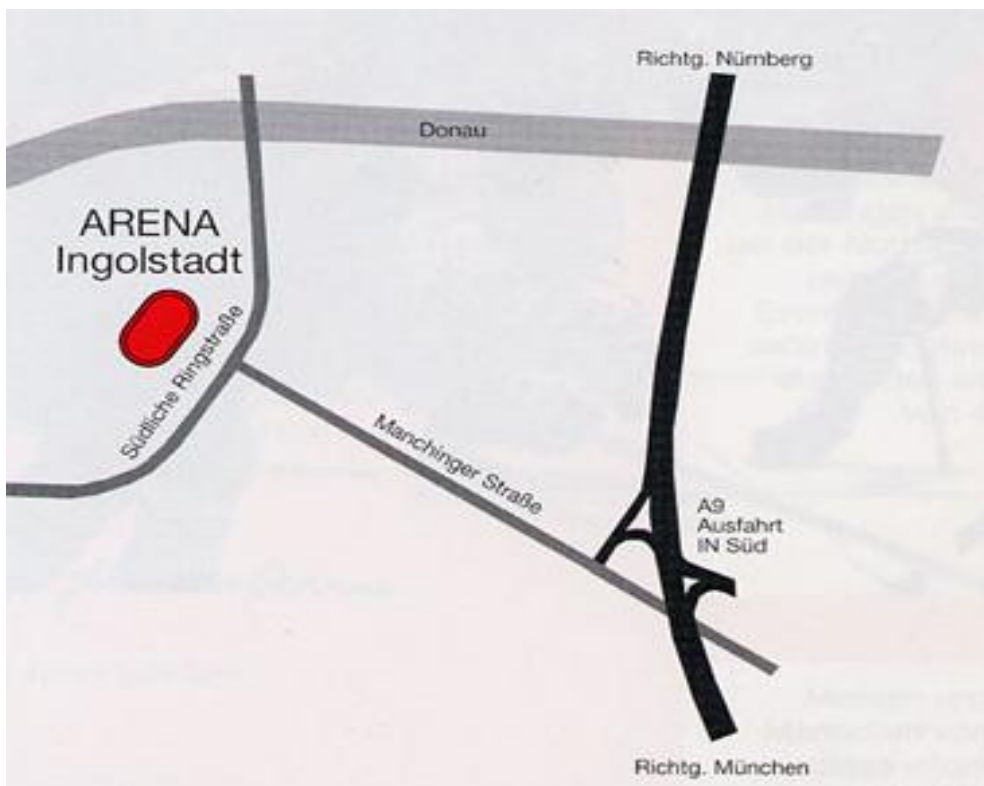
A change of the age category is not possible. The Team Competitors can only start in the respectively age category

Trophies for places 1 - 5 for clubs,
