Article: 10.7 Random weight control	
WT may conduct random weight control of athletes on the day of competition. Athletes that have a weight increase of more than 5% above the weight division where they weighed-in will be disqualified. Random weight control shall be made in only one attempt per contestant, there will be no second try.	WT may conduct random weight control of athletes on the day of competition. <u>5-50% of athletes in a weight category may be selected for random weigh-in.</u> Athletes that have a weight increase of more than 5% above the weight division where they weighed-in will be disqualified. Random weight control shall be made in only one attempt per contestant, there will be no second try. <u>“Over” weight categories are not subject to random weigh-in.</u>
