1. Tournament date: 23-26.06.2023

2. City: Krynica-Zdrój

3. Competition Venue: Krynica-Zdroj Arena, 5 Park Sportowy, 33-380 Krynica-Zdroj, Poland (original name: Hala Lodowa MOSiR w Krynicy-Zdroju – Lodowisko). Shuttle bus line A12.

4. Training Venue: Krynica-Zdroj Training Hall, 3 Nadbrzeżna Street, 33-380 Krynica-Zdroj, Poland (original name: Zespół Szkół Ponadpodstawowych). Shuttle bus line TD.

10. Head of Team/Teams’ Leaders Meeting:

21 June 2023, 16:00-18:00, Hotel “Krynica” Conference Hall.

Special shuttle buses will be available.

At least one representative from each team must attend the head of team meeting. In case of no representative can be at the meeting, the team must designate a proxy and inform the technical delegate or Competition Management department before the meeting.

- a. Registration of the team and confirmation of athletes’ participation and information.
- b. Explanation of competition procedures.
- c. Explanation of competition rules and interpretation.
- d. Draw of Lots procedure.
- e. BIB (Start) Numbers - distributions for teams.
- f. Daily access pass stickers – distribution for teams.

11. Medal Ceremony: Athletes will be required to wear their Dobok throughout the Medal Ceremony.




12. WT-RECOGNIZED Taekwondo competition uniform and protective equipment:

- a. **Daedo** Protector and Scoring System (PSS) including PSS Head-gear will be used for the games.
- b. Participating contestants are required to wear WT-recognized competition uniform and WT-recognized protective equipment.
- c. The latest version of WT recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT: <http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtpartners-wt/reconize.html>
- d. The Organizing Committee will provide Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants.
- e. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthpieces, gloves, sensing socks, and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.
- f. Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for inspection of their competition uniforms and protective equipment.
- g. **Any contestant who wears unofficial competition uniforms or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.**

13. Venue access: During the Head of Team meeting, team leaders will receive daily passes (in the form of stickers on IDs) for athletes for each competition day. The sticker with the number of the competition day should be affixed to the athlete's ID next to their photo. Upon entry to the venue, athletes will be selected based on the color of their sticker. Athletes competing on a given day will have access to the Field of Play, Changing Rooms, Warm-Up Area and Athletes' Refreshments Area while other athletes will only have access to designated seating areas.

14. Trainings: Trainings take place only in the Training Hall (not in the venue). All Training sessions on 21-26 June 2023 are pre-allocated. Each pre-allocated Training session will last 90 minutes. Training sessions for teams throughout the Taekwondo tournament period (pre-competition days and competition days) can be booked via email: tkw.training.booking@ie2023.pl until June 19, 2023. Upon arrival, booking training sessions will only be possible at the Sport Information Center and Sport Information Desk.

Teams with 8-10 team members will have one competition area at their disposal, and 11-16 team members will have two competition areas at their disposal. All other Teams will be sharing competition areas.

15. Athletes Village (AVL)/Hotels/Accommodation: All teams/National Olympic Committees (NOCs) will be accommodated in hotels. The hotels are situated approximately 1.5 kilometers away from the Krynica Arena Venue. Shuttle bus pick-up points are conveniently located near the hotels.

16. Shuttle Bus Service: OC will provide a regular shuttle service between Athletes' Villages (Hotels), Main Accreditation Centre, Competition Venue / Training Venue, Officials Hotel. The shuttle service will run every 30-45 minutes and during rush hours every 15-20 minutes. The shuttle service will start operating two days before the first game starts and will end one day after the last game ends at each Sports Venue. On an operating day the shuttle service will start running two hours before the first activities at the and the last shuttle vehicle will leave 90 minutes after the last game.

17. Meals: All meals will be served at the hotels for all participants. In addition, athletes will have access to snacks and drinks in designated areas, such as the Venue Athletes' Refreshment Area, Athletes' Lounge, and Training Hall. The Athletes' Refreshments Area within the competition venue is only accessible to athletes competing on that specific day. However, athletes not competing can use the Athletes' Lounge, which is located in the city center, during their entire stay.

18. BIB (start) numbers: Each Athlete will be assigned a unique BIB Number (in the form of a sticker). Team Leaders will be provided with the BIB numbers for their team during the Team Leaders' Meeting.



19. Others: Volunteers will be present to assist you. You can find all the necessary information at the Sport Information Center and the Sport Information Desk.
