Criterion #3	Holder of active WT Global Athlete License(GAL)
Criterion #4	Holder of the Kukkiwon Dan Certificate

**** Athletes are able to register on all 3 events : Athlete registered in Individual event can also participate in Pair and Mixed Gender Team event, as long as the athlete forms the team.**

**** Athlete are required to choose one(1) division in each category**

- e.g. In case an athlete participating in M-68kg Individual wants to participate in Pair and Mixed Gender Team event, he must choose one(1) division from each event.

7.1 Weigh-In

* General weigh-on of the contestants shall take place on the day before their respective division

* During the weigh-in, male contestants shall wear underpants and female contestants shall wear underpants and brassieres. However, contestants may weigh-in in the nude if they wish to do so.

7.2 Substitute athlete(s) shall participate in the weigh-in as well.

* In the event that an athlete who has already weighed in for the Male Team or Female Team competition is registered as a substitute, the pertinent athlete is not required to undergo weigh-in again

7.3 If substitute athlete replaces an existing athlete(s), the total weight of athletes for each event category, including the substitute athlete(s), excluding the replaced athlete(s), shall be recalculated and applied

8. COMPETITION RULES & METHODS

- Single elimination system
- Athletes are allowed to participate up to 3 events (e.g. W-57kg, Female Pair -110kg and Mixed Gender)
- Detailed information related to the Octagon Diamond Game will comply with the Technical Guideline provided on WT Website(URL)
- Individual : Best of Three(3) System will be applied
- Pair : Best of Three(3) System will be applied with tag (refer to B. Pair Match Format)
- Mixed Gender Team : Best of Three(3) system will be applied with tag (refer to C. Mixed Gender Team Match Format)
- Event Grade : G-4(Team Ranking) : Only applies to Mixed Gender Team
- Number of Court : One(1)
- Energy Deduction System
 - The “Energy Meter” will be applied, starting with 150 or 200 Energy Meter each team
 - Each round, when the “Energy” reaches zero(0), the opponent shall be declared as the winner of the round
 - In case neither teams’ Energy Meters reach zero(0) within given period, the team with higher Energy meter shall be declared as the winner of the round
 - Valid points(Energy Meter) are as follows:

Scoring Area	Energy Meter (Total 200)
Valid Punch to Trunk Protector	- 5
Attack while/after stepping on the Wall	Additional -5
Valid Kick to the Trunk Protector	- 10
Valid Kick to the Head	- 15
Valid Turning Kick to Trunk Protector	- 20
Valid Turning Kick to the Head	- 25
Passive Behavior	Deduction X 2 for 10 seconds

- Substitute(s)
 - Each team may bring minimum four(4) athletes, and six(6) athletes for Mixed Gender Team which includes one(1) substitute per gender
 - Replacement of a competitor with the substitute shall only be allowed between matches, not allowed during the match.
 - In the event of an injury during the competition, exclusively for the *Mixed Gender Team*, a team of three(3) athletes can still be formed and compete. However, the opponent will be awarded 10 points in the 1st round
- Prohibited acts and penalties
 - **Passive behavior, avoiding or delaying the match**
 - * Center referee will give Gam-jeom and declare "Sip-Cho(10 seconds) to the contestant/team, and the opponent will have chance of doubling the score (deducting opponent's) within given time.
 - Grabbing the opponent
 - Attacking the opponent after "Kal-yeo"
 - Attacking the fallen opponent
 - Misconduct of contestant(s) or coach

A. Individual Match Format

- i. All contest shall be carried out for 3(or 2) rounds – 2 minutes per round with 1 minute break between rounds
- ii. The contestant will be declared as loser when total Gam-jeom reaches 40 in any time of the match
- iii. There is no point gap

B. Pair Match Format (Male, Female)

- i. Each team must enter 2 athletes
- ii. All contests shall be carried out for 3(or 2) rounds – 2 minutes per round with 1 minute break between rounds, based on tag team match format (or 1 minute 30 seconds per round)
- iii. Substitution of competitor(tag) shall be allowed without any limit, but each competitor must fight for 15 seconds or more to be replaced
 - A. When the team makes substitution(tag), the opponent cannot make substitution for 10 seconds, regardless of the time the opponent had remaining for substitution.
- iv. The team will be declared as loser when total Gam-jeom reaches 40 in any time of the match
- v. There is no point gap

C. Mixed Gender Team Match Format

- i. Each team must have at least 2 female athletes and 2 male athletes
- ii. Athletes are numbered from 1(lighter) to 2(heavier) for female and 3(lighter) and 4(heavier) for male athletes
- iii. All contest shall be carried out as for 3(or 2) rounds – 3 minutes per round with 1 minute break between rounds, based on tag team match format
- iv. The 1st round shall start with choice of Chung's female athlete
- v. The 2nd round shall start with choice of Hong's female athlete
- vi. In case of 3rd round, it shall start with the male athlete, and each side must match same gender for every bout
- vii. Replacement of competitors(tag) shall be allowed without any limit, but each competitor must fight for 15 seconds or more to be replaced. Replacement can only be made if the match is reasonably interrupted.
 - A. When the team makes substitution(tag), the opponent cannot make substitution for 10 seconds, regardless of the time the opponent had remaining for substitution
- viii. The team will be declared as loser when total Gam-jeom reaches 40 in any time of the match
- ix. There is no point gap

9. WT GLOBAL LICENCE & ONLINE REGISTRATION

- i. WT Global Licence Registration

All athletes and team officials must FIRST be registered with a WT Global Athlete Licence (GAL) or Global Official Licence (GOL).

- ii. WT Online Registration
 Entry will only be accepted through the WT online registration system and registration is only possible with a valid WT Global Licence.

10. ENTRY FEES

REGULAR ENTRY FEES

There is no entry fee for Muju Taekwondowon 2024 World Taekwondo Octagon Diamond Game.

- Athlete can register up to three(3) events, under condition that the athlete will participate
- Registration will begin on June 1, 17:01, local time in Switzerland.
- Registration will end on August 9th, 08:00, local time in Switzerland.
- Any WT Global Licence registration completed onsite will be charged a US\$50 onsite processing fee for each WT Global Licence required.
- Each team can register online for maximum
 - o One(1) Head of Team
 - o One(1) Manager
 - o Two(2) Coaches
 - o One(1) Team doctor
 - o Three(3) MNA Officials

11. CLASSIFICATION OF RESULTS

Medals will be awarded to the top three teams in the respective weight category of the pertinent competition:

The prize money will be paid in Korean Won(KRW) in accordance with the regulation for subsidies in the Republic of Korea. Moreover, taxes will be deducted based on each country's tax policy, then it will be transferred to winners in US Dollar(USD). The KRW-USD currency exchange rate of transaction date will be applied. (As of July 17, 1 USD = 1,386.00 KRW)

1st PLACE:	GOLD MEDALS & CERTIFICATES + Prize Money (15,000,000 KRW)
2nd PLACE:	SILVER MEDALS & CERTIFICATES + Prize Money (5,000,000 KRW)
3rd PLACES:	BRONZE MEDALS & CERTIFICATES

For Pair

1st PLACE:	GOLD MEDALS & CERTIFICATES + Prize Money (3,000,000KRW)
2nd PLACE:	SILVER MEDALS & CERTIFICATES + Prize Money (2,000,000 KRW)
3rd PLACE:	BRONZE MEDALS & CERTIFICATES

12. WT-RECOGNIZED TAEKWONDO COMPETITION UNIFORM AND PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- i. **Protector and Scoring System (PSS) including PSS Headgear** will be used for the competition.
- ii. Participating contestants are required to wear **WT-recognized Kyorugi competition uniform or Dobok** and WT-recognized protective equipment.
- iii. **For Mixed Gender Team, male athletes must wear black Dobok pants.**
The latest version of WT-recognized manufacturers' list is available at the website of WT. (<http://www.worldtaekwondo.org/wtpartners-wt/recognize.html>).
- iv. The Organizing Committee will provide Protector and Scoring System (PSS) to the participating contestants. Participating contestants are required to bring their own groin guards, mouthguard, gloves, sensing socks and shin and forearm guards for their personal use.
- v. Before entering the field of play, all contestants will proceed to the inspection desk for inspection of their competition uniform and protective equipment. **Any contestant who wears unofficial competition uniform, Dobok or protective equipment will not be permitted to compete.**
- vi. The top has to cover completely the buttocks. However, the bottom of top should be more than 15cm above the knee cap

13. IDENTIFICATION OF NOC CODE AND MANUFACTURER

- i. National flag shall be located between 3 to 3.5cm below from the shoulder line of the right arm.
- ii. NOC Code is a three-letter National Olympic committee abbreviation, and it must be printed at the back in black and centred at 5cm or higher from the bottom line of the upper garment within the size of 30cm width x 12cm height. The font of the letters shall be in bold "Verdana".
- iii. Manufacturer's identifications (name, designation trademark, logo or any distinctive sign of the manufacturer) shall be located one for the top of Kyorugi competition uniform within 30cm² and between 3 to 3.5cm below the shoulder line of the left arm, one for bottoms of Kyorugi competition uniform or within 30cm² located above the knee and center of the right leg, and one for Kyorugi belt within 6cm² at the end of the belt.

14. SPONSOR'S IDENTIFICATION

- i. ONE sponsor's identification (logo) is allowed to each of Kyorugi competition uniform's top and bottoms.
- ii. The sponsor's identification shall be located within 50cm² except the location of WT logo, manufacturer's identification, national flag, and NOC code.

15. MEDICAL CONTROL

- i. The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and where necessary the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions.
- ii. Compulsory anti-doping tests will be carried out for selected medalists, while random tests will be conducted to the rest of the athletes. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out-of-competition testing prior to the championships.
- iii. TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption)
Athletes who take any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, together with the required medical information. If you do not have an ADAMS account yet, please contact tue@ita.sport to have it set up.

Otherwise, please download the TUE Application Form and once duly completed and signed, send it together with the required medical file to tue@ita.sport with copy to antidoping@worldtaekwondo.org. by at least 30 days before the first competition day.

16. HEAD OF TEAM MEETING & DRAWING OF LOTS SESSION

- i. The head of team meeting shall be conducted one (1) day prior to the start of the competition that is September 5th, in the presence of the WT officials and the representatives of the participating teams.
- ii. At least one representative from each team must attend the head of team meeting. In case of no representative can be at the meeting, the team must designate a proxy and inform Technical Delegate or WT Sport & Event Management department before the meeting.
- iii. The method of draw shall be decided by the Technical Delegate

17. INDEMNITIES

- i. The respective national taekwondo associations shall be responsible for ensuring that all officials and participants are covered with effective travel & medical insurance coverage.
- ii. Participants without proper insurance coverage will not be allowed to compete at the competition.
- iii. The Organizing Committee will acquire general Public Liability event insurance.

18. ACCOMMODATION & TRANSPORTATION

The participating teams are required to complete the Accommodation Booking Form (available on Simply Compete) and return it to reserve@tpf.or.kr no later than Friday, 9th August.

When you submit the booking form the OC will send a confirmation letter with the invoice. Payments can be made by **credit card on-site only**; cash is not allowed.

All accommodation rates are quoted in KRW and include bed and all taxes, Wi-Fi, airport transfers and shuttle services to the training and competition venue.

Meals are not included in the room rates, but the OC will add the amount of meals on the invoice as selected on the Accommodation Booking Form

19. VISA INFORMATION

The Organizing Committee can provide invitation letters for visa applications. Please send invitation letter request form via email mujuoctagon@tpf.or.kr no later than Friday, 9th August.

For your information, please check <http://www.korea-visa/> for more information.

However, participants are required to check the entry to Korea from their own countries and submit requests for recommendation letters to the Organizing Committee. The Organizing Committee cannot guarantee entry into Korea and can only offer assistance. It is the responsibility of each participant to apply for and secure the correct entry visa. Please keep in mind that the process time to obtain a Korean visa can be up to 2 months.

20. COACH'S REQUIREMENTS

All coaches are required to hold WT Coach Certificate Level (2). **Coaches who do not hold Level II coach certificate will be deleted from the registration and not allowed to coach at the Championships**

All coaches are required to wear formal suit such as tie, jacket, dress shirt (long or short), and trousers, and sport shoes during Semi-Finals and Finals. Any type of cap/hat is not allowed. If any coach refuses to wear abovementioned attire, he or she will not be allowed to coach for the event.
